

## News on our Century College scholarship selection

At our May annual meeting Leah Marie and LouAnn volunteered to select our AAUW Northeast Metro Branch - Nancy Jo Hendrickson Legacy Scholarship and in addition the AAUW Northeast Metro Branch Scholarship recipients for 2020-2021. The "branch" scholarship is funded this year by Century Foundation. Jill Greenhalgh, Century Foundation President, had told Christine and Doris last fall that to thank our branch for its support over the past 35 years, she would try to find funding for our branch scholarship which she apparently achieved. If you recall with our branch restructuring, we had decided to no longer financially support the branch scholarship.

Last week we heard from Jessica Ward who is the person from Century College leading the scholarship process. She shared this morning that there were 37 applicants for the legacy scholarship and 31 applicants for the branch scholarship with some overlap. Their team will be selecting the three finalists for each of the two scholarships which will be forwarded to Leah Marie and LouAnn. The plan is for the selection to be made by June 1.
